



2010 Legislative Calendar

Jan. 15 - Last day for policy committees to hear and report bills introduced in 2009 for referral to fiscal committees. Jan. 22 - Last day for any committee to hear and report to the Floor bills introduced in their house in 2009.

Jan. 31 - Last day for each house to pass bills introduced in their own house in 2009 Feb. 19 - Last day for new bills to be introduced

Mar. 25 - Spring Recess begins upon adjournment

Apr. 5 - Legislature reconvenes from Spring Recess

Apr. 23 - Last day for policy committees to hear and report to fiscal committees fiscal bills introduced in their house

May 7 - Last day for policy committees to hear and report to the floor nonfiscal bills introduced in their house

May 14 - Last day for policy committees to meet prior to June 7

May 28 - Last day for fiscal committees to hear and report to the floor bills introduced in their house. Last day for fiscal committees to meet prior to June 7.

Jun. 1-4 - Floor session only. No committee may meet for any purpose

Jun. 4 - Last day to pass bills out of house of origin

Jun. 7 - Committee meetings may resume

Jun. 15 - Budget Bill is supposed to be passed by midnight

Jun. 24 - Last day for a legislative measure to qualify for the Nov. 2 General Election ballot.

July 2 - Last day for policy committees to hear and report bills. Summer Recess begins on adjournment, provided Budget Bill has been passed.

Aug. 2 - Legislature reconvenes from Summer Recess

Aug. 13 - Last day for fiscal committees to hear and report bills to the Floor

Aug. 16 - 31 - Floor session only. No committee may meet for any purpose Aug. 20 - Last day to amend on the Floor

Aug. 31 - Last day for any bill to be passed. Final Recess begins on adjournment

Sept. 30 - Last day for Governor to sign or veto bills
